**Cannabis Voting History**

HB 332 6/7/16	Adding misdemeanor possession of cannabis and paraphernalia offenses to the list of violations and offenses for which a person may be eligible for probation before judgment	Yes
HB 400 7/1/16	“Bob’s Bill” – classifying pain, anxiety, or depression, if related to terminal illness as a qualifying condition in the Delaware Medical Marijuana Act	Absent
SB 24 6/30/17	Removing the requirement that a psychiatrist be the physician who signs the written certification in support of an applicant’s application for medical cannabis and adding anxiety to the list of debilitating conditions which a person can have to be eligible for medical cannabis.	Yes
HB 210 7/2/17	Allowing minors subject to debilitating medical conditions not specifically listed in § 4906A(b) the same petition process to have their condition considered as that allowed for adults.	Yes
HB 110 6/28/18	Legalizing cannabis for adults 21 and older and creating a regulated market for cannabis.	Yes
